Vega-Arny , 1970-72

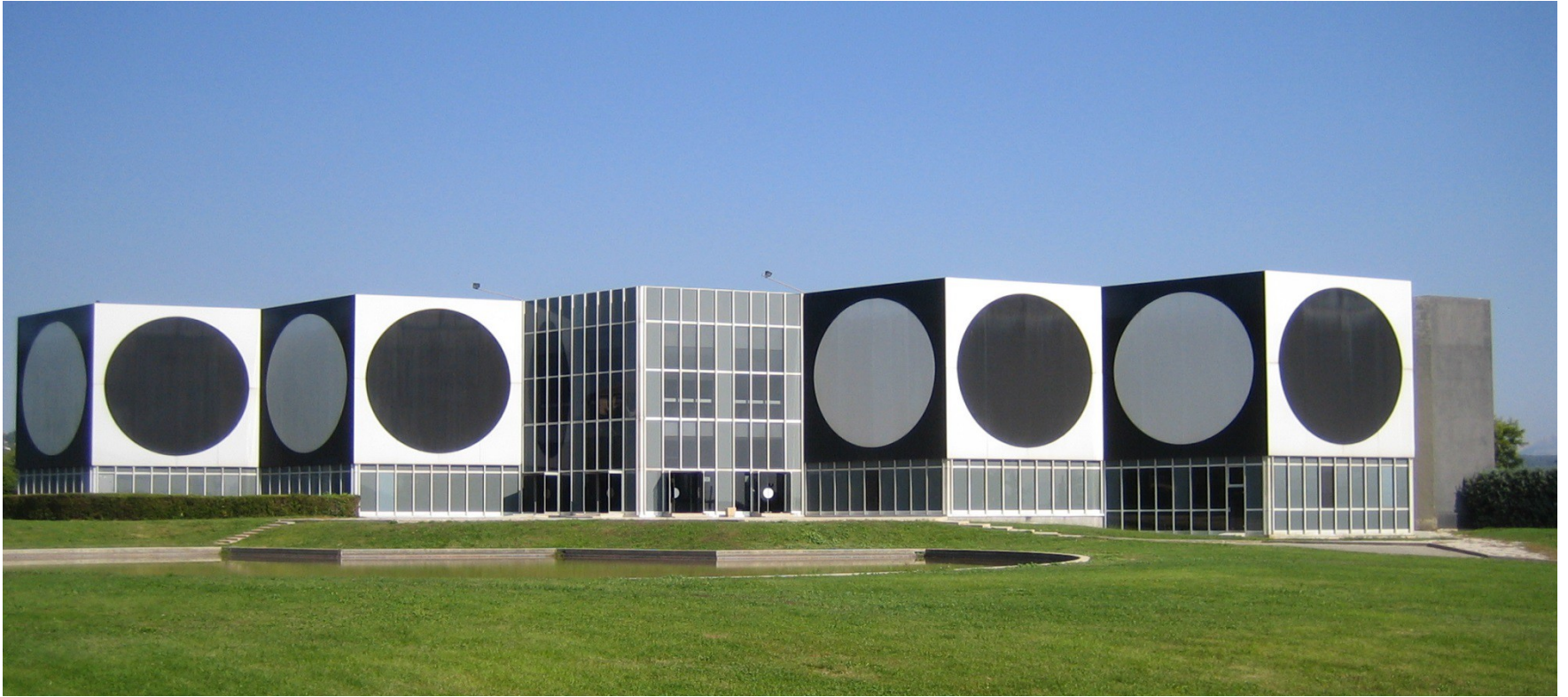

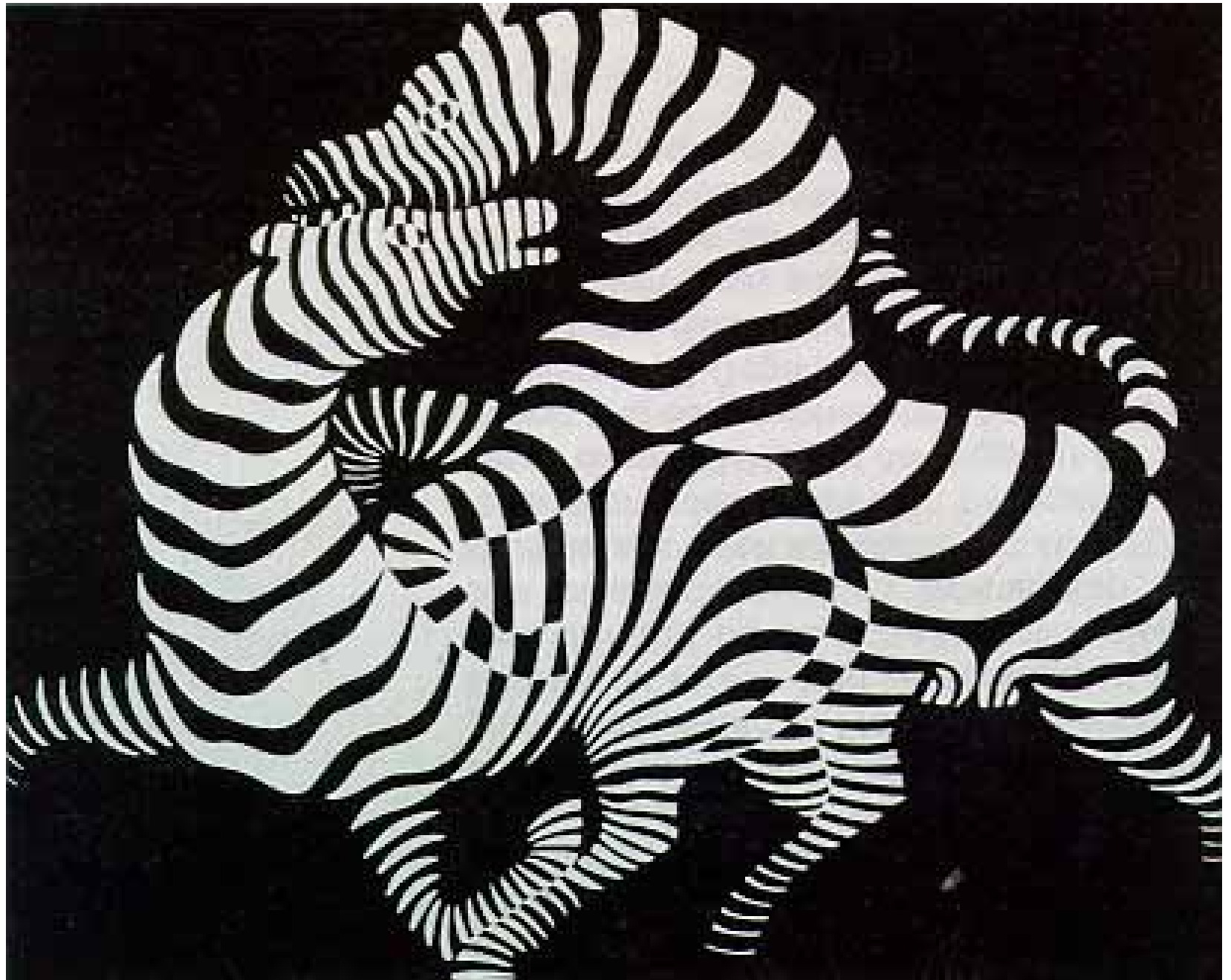




Zebra (1938),
